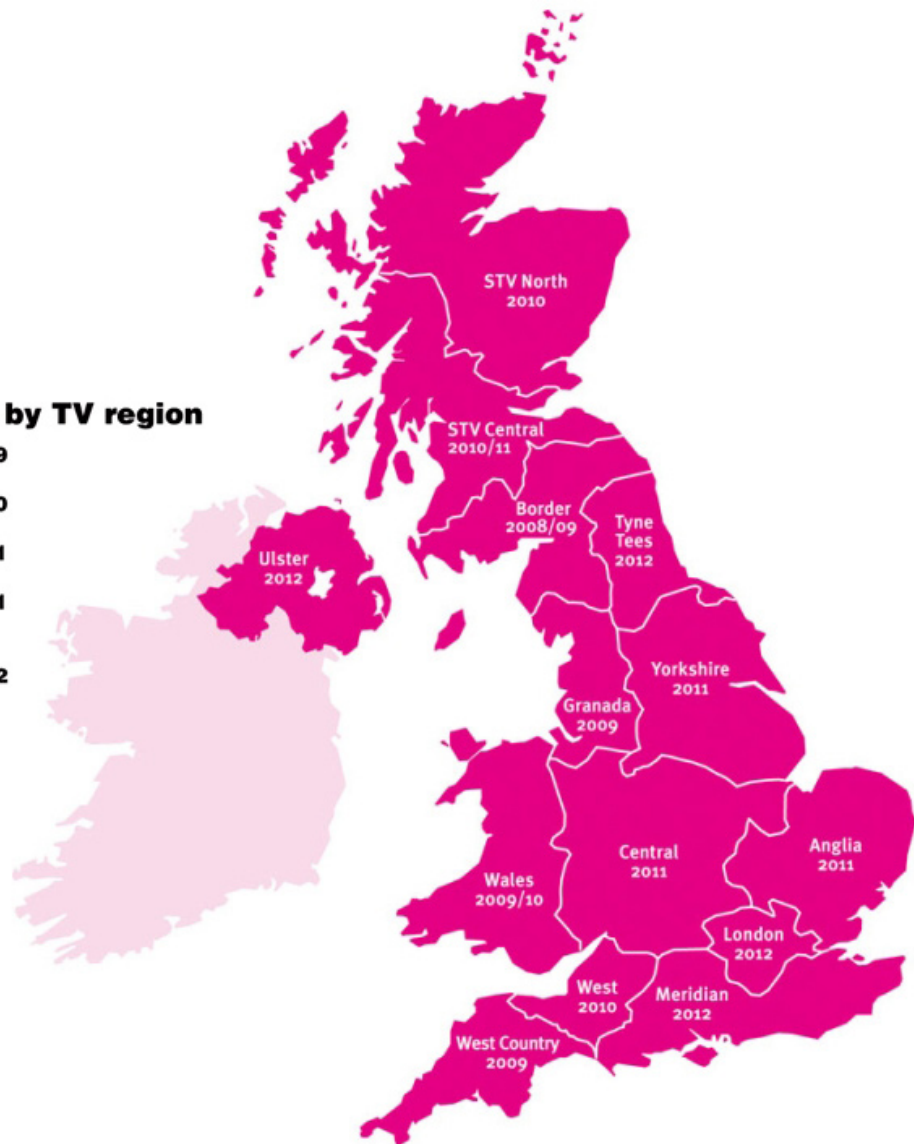


Digital Switchover Region by Region

You'll need a freesat Digital Box for each TV you want to convert to freesat.

Which freesat product should I buy?

You've got a range of options to choose from, including freesat High Definition Digital Boxes, Standard Definition Digital Boxes and High Definition Digital TV Recorders with either 320GB or 500GB of memory.

What if I've already got a satellite dish and cabling?

You may be able to use your existing installation. All you'll need is a freesat Digital Box for each TV you want to convert to freesat.

What sort of installation will I need?

You'll need a satellite dish to receive freesat. If there's already one on your home you may be able to use it, but your local freesat approved retailer will be able to recommend the best installation for you. A standard installation starts from around £80.
